ULS Statement on the Murder of our Member Isaac Sendegeya on Saturday 20th July 2019

The Uganda Law Society (ULS) received with shock the unfortunate news of the murder of our member Mr. Isaac Sendegeya. It is unfortunate that the life of a vibrant young lawyer who had a lot to give to the country and to his family was brutally terminated.

We express our condolences to the family of Isaac Sendegeya and mourn with you and pray for the hand of the almighty God to comfort you all in this difficult time.

The ULS condemns in the strongest terms the killing of Mr. Sendegeya and many other Ugandans in the recent past. We condemn all acts of violence that result in the killing of Ugandans. These crimes are an assault to the integrity of the State and, they should draw the concern of every major stakeholder and stiffen their resolve to have a common effort to ensure means to combat such crime.

We call upon the police and all the agents responsible to conduct an immediate, impartial and transparent investigation into the murder of Mr. Sendegeya and ensure that the suspect(s) face the full extent of the law. We equally demand that the Government takes all steps necessary to ensure the security of all citizens.

The ULS pledges to follow this matter keenly to ensure that justice is done and the perpetrator(s) are brought to book through a lawful process
